### **Day 3: Double Decker Living Root Bridge.**

After breakfast, head to a top attraction; the legendary '**Double-Decker Living Root Bridges**'. Deep in the dense tropical forest of Meghalaya, and shrouded in cloud and rain for much of the year, are some astonishing man-made natural wonders. Known as living root bridges, inventive members of the Khasi tribe have trained them to grow from the roots of ancient rubber trees, native to the northeast region. The root bridges provide a stable alternative to wooden bridges, which decay and get destroyed during the lengthy monsoon seasons. The path to the double-decker root bridge is three Kilometres (nearly two miles) long. It has approximately 3,500 stairs and descends 2,400 feet. Those are some daunting figures, but don't let it put you off! There are three parts to the trek. The steepest and most challenging part is the first part, down the hill to Nongthymmai village (where the longest root bridge, Ritymmen, is located). It takes about 45 minutes, along a seemingly endless trail of steps that plunges deeper and deeper into the forest. It seems like paradise, with jack fruits and pineapples growing wildly amid the jungle of vegetation. Trek further ahead to see the beautiful '**Rainbow Falls**'. The Rainbow Falls is called so because you can always see a rainbow over it when there is Sunshine. Later by evening head back to your hotel. **Overnight in Cheerapunjee.**
