Day 1: Arrival at Cochin. Transfers to Alleppey. Overnight in Houseboat.

With a greenery view of the countryside outside and comfort stay inside, get ready to spice up the experience. **Overnight in Houseboat**.

Day 2: Alleppey to Kollam (90km/3hrs). Overnight in Kollam.

After breakfast, proceed to **Kollam**. On arrival, you are at leisure in the Resort or for own Activities. **Overnight in Kollam**.

Day 3: Kollam - Varkala - Trivandrum (70km/3hrs). Overnight in Trivandrum.

The Fort is remembered as one of the most important historical sites as it was the first British settlement in India. The architectural design is admirable and the Fort itself is located in picturesque settings. The Lighthouse is also known to have guided British Ships to shore and from the vantage point, it offers awe-inspiring views of the sea. Later, if time permits you could also visit the **Janardana Swami Temple**, also known as **Varkala Temple**. This 2000 year old temple is situated on top of a small hill near **Papanasam/ Varkala Beach** and you will need to climb stairs to reach the temple. This will be an offbeat experience for people who love history and Indian culture. Further proceed to **Trivandrum**. Visit **Shree Padmanabhaswamy Temple (on own)**; considered as the World's Richest Religious Site due to donations that it has been receiving over the ages. Note:

Dress Code to Enter Shree Padmanabhaswamy Temple

- The dress code for Men is Mund / Dhoti with or without Angavastra. Men need to wear Mundu or Dhoti and should not wear shirts of any kind.

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- The dress code for Women are Sarees with blouse, Chudidar or other coverings as apporiate to their age.

Day 4: Kanyakumari Day Trip (200km/6hrs). Overnight in Trivandrum.

After breakfast, proceed for a day trip to the **Southern Tip of India - 'Kanyakumari'**. Visit **Devi Kanyakumari Temple (on own)** and then head towards the colossal and imposing **'Vivekananda Rock Memorial' (on own)**. Upon arrival at **Cochin International Airport (arrive by 9AM)**, you shall be picked up in your exclusive vehicle and transferred to **Athirappally**. A scenic beauty, the **Athirappally Falls** has guest-starred in lots of Bollywood Movies. This 80 ft high monstrous waterfall joins the Chalakudy River after plunging down 80 ft from the top. It's also called **'The Niagara of India'** because of its close resemblance to the Niagara Falls in the United States. For nature lovers, this place is God's gift. **Overnight in Athirappally**.

Day 2: Athirappally to Munnar (130km/4hrs). Overnight in Munnar.

After breakfast, build your journey with resplendent nature scenes of beautiful streams, small waterfalls, plantations of tea, spices and rubber, interspersed with tropical thickets. '**Munnar'** is Kerala's shining star. Munnar is also called the '**Kashmir of South India'** and is a favourite destination for honeymoon. Upon arrival, check in at your resort and spend the evening at leisure, gazing the vast expanse of **Tea Gardens** as you immerse yourself in the dusk of the setting sun. **Overnight in Munnar**.

evening, you can enjoy an **Elephant Safari (own cost)** inside the jungle. Elephant Safari is common among tourists as it is easier to cover trails that are harder to reach. Moreover, elephant safaris provide more interesting experience than jeep or others. Since tigers are afraid to attack elephants, it is a safer option for those who want to spot a few tigers. **Overnight in Thekaddy.**

Day 5: Thekkady - Malarikkal - Alleppey (140km/4hrs). Overnight in Houseboat.
